Items Required at the Tournament:
Signed Liability Waiver (parents do this when accept invite to the roster on TeamSnap
Tournaments)
Player birthday documentation (birth certificate, passport, state ID) must be available on
site at all times (do not need to turn in)

Important information to relay to the parents and fans that will be attending:

- Tournament schedule, game scores, and brackets will be updated regularly in TeamSnap Tournaments app.
